Winter Camp Packing List

- **Winter coat**
- Snow pants or Snow bibs
- Winter hat
- Thick gloves
- Snow boots
- Warm clothing for the 3-day, 2 night retreat
- Several extra pairs of socks
- Inside shoes (*We require everyone to take their wet/muddy boots and shoes off at the entrance to the dining hall in order to avoid the hazard of wet, slippery floors.*)
- Sleeping bag and/or linens
- Pillow
- Toiletries and shower items
- Towel
- Bible (*Any translation is acceptable. Please make sure the Bible has chapter and verse references.*)
- Flashlight
- **Waterbottle** (*Very important as outdoor water fountains are turned off during the winter.*)

Please remember that we will spend a significant amount of time outside and temperatures may be cold, especially in the evenings. Send lots of warm clothes, layers, and winter gear with your camper. Even if there is not snow, your camper may appreciate these items for protection from cold and mud. Campers who arrive without a coat will be required to go home and get one before they can stay.
